NINTH DAY — PRAYER FOR FINAL PERSEVERANCE



Recite one Our Father and one Hail Mary.

DAILY NOVENA

FIRST DAY— PRAYER FOR SINCERE REPENTANCE

O glorious St. Peregrine, true model of conversion to God, where once you gave yourself to God, you generously entered the religious Order of Servants of Mary and henceforth led a life of heroic penance.

Obtain for me, I beseech you, the grace to never return to my sins, to do penance for them, and from now on, to lead a holy and fervent life.
