

It is often said this way in the Czech Republic, Austria, Germany, etc. My confessor in Medjugorje told me that he said it that way. John Haffert, the Co-Founder of the Blue Army, whose Rosary recitation was thoroughly inspiring, added a Scriptural Phrase before each "Hail Mary."

Since I had so many Rosaries to say, I chose to add only one or two words. For example: in the Glorious Mysteries, after the word "Jesus," I added: 1) raised, 2) ascends, 3) Spirit comes, 4) Mother assumed, 5) Mother crowned. It was absolutely great!

Generally, distractions flew away, I was always able to start and stop after each decade to do other things, and when I picked up the beads again, amazingly, I always knew exactly where I had left off and which mystery was next. It was wonderful!

I restructured my prayers some-what, and I found that my prayer life began to be tremendously enriched. In an effort to reach the goal, I started wasting less time during the day. I was thinking more intensely about God and the Mysteries. I was baffled and inebriated with the excitement of it. My relationship with God was more intimate. It was great! Since then, I have been doing it on and off for various petitions with amazingly positive results.

Thus, when I received Susan's letter, I responded that I'll add to her wealth of spiritual ammunition, and soon begin praying these seven daily Rosaries for her and her family.

TO ACCOMPLISH IT

Note: make your request open ended. If you ask to marry John, but God knows that you will meet Henry next year, and with him it will be a better marriage, do not think that God did not answer your prayer. In other words, let God decide what is the best answer, and *that* is what He will *always* give to you.


Also, if you do not complete the Rosaries on any one of the days, you must start all over again, and if you obtain your request before the seven days are finished, which often happens, you must *still* pray the Rosaries for the entire seven days.

This program is not for the faint hearted, but rather it is for the prayerful ones, for the confident ones, and for the desperate ones. If you are one of these kinds of people, you might want to try it and see what happens.

Recently I went to Bill Dragon's funeral. He was my former accountant, and his grown children would make anyone proud. They are ardent Catholics, as well as being accomplished musicians and professionals. They even sang and played at the funeral, and, as funerals can be beautiful, this one was.

His son, George, came with some of his five young children, but Susan, their mother, was unable to come because of her intense pain from breast and bone cancer. Hearing this, I thought that I might never see her again. Later, in October, she sent me this encouraging letter. She said:

"We are all well. I am amazingly having a major reversal in cancer within the last 6 weeks. On Sept. 20, it was not noticeable to me when George's Mom presented me with a relic on a neck chain, of St. John Neumann. I immediately put on the relic and began a novena to him.

"At the same time, I began 10 radiation treatments in the hips, as the cancer was great in the bones there and I had much pain. On the 2nd day of radiation on the hips, I noticed an improvement in my breast!

"I asked the doctor of radiology if the treatments could reduce cancer to the breast, even though it was directed at the hips. He said...*no, that he could not take credit for that!*

"Again, after the 7th treatment, I asked him if it was possible that my breast reduction and cancer tumors that had spread out from the left to the right breast and beyond, could be affected by the hip radiation. Again, he said...*no, but he had no answers!*

"I cannot tell you how exciting this has been for me. I was totally expecting to be dead by now—but here I am—healing, and feeling good!

"Now I just have to keep up my prayer life and appreciate each day, and *thank God* for all He allows to happen!

"What a wonderful surprise He has given to me! So, unless I stop healing, which I have not, I will not need the chemotherapy treatments (another prayer answered).

"I tried all the natural stuff, and am still doing one more, but I totally believe that *God's mercy is healing me*. Well...love and thanks to all."

MY RESPONSE

When I was on pilgrimage in France in September, we had two unknown visionaries along with us. One of them had a vision of St. Philomena some time back, and she told him, "If you want anything badly, say seven Rosaries a day for seven consecutive days, and you will get what you are asking for, *or something better.*"

WE TRIED IT

At first I thought, seven Rosaries a day!! *Can I possibly do it??* Well, there is no harm in trying. What can I lose? I know a rather famous Filipino priest on E.W.T.N., who recently confided to a group of us that he says 10 Rosaries a day! Sister Agnes Sasagowa's superior told me that Sr. Agnes says 20 Rosaries a day, (to which Sr. Agnes responded...*"Not enough...not enough"*), and Padre Pio said 30 Rosaries a day!

On the Pilgrimage, quite a few members in our group agreed to try it. After the first seven days, I was so impressed with the results, that I immediately started praying for a 2nd request, *which I also received!* I was so grateful that I did it a third time, *in thanksgiving for the first two!*

PROBLEMS

In the beginning, I was up late into the night in order to finish. Then I fought distractions. I remembered a confession that I had made in Medjugorje long ago, confessing that I gave way to distractions, and the European priest suggested that I incorporate a phrase from the scriptures in each prayer, called the Scriptural Rosary, either before each "Hail Mary," or after the word, "Jesus."
