

Souls to Pray for at Each Station of the Cross

Each station of the cross have souls assigned to them waiting for our prayers. Below is a suggested list you may want to consider when praying the Station of the Cross.

- Station 1: For all my enemies
- Station 2: For my spiritual and temporal benefactors
- Station 3: For all those who suffer the most
- Station 4: For the relatives of my family
- Station 5: For those who in purgatory are the most forgotten and abandoned
- Station 6: For those whose liberation from Purgatory is remote
- Station 7: For all of those, who because of me, have suffered or been hurt
- Station 8: For harden sinners, who owe their salvation to some miracle
- Station 9: For those who are luke-warm and who dedicate little time to prayer
- Station 10: For those who sought out the pleasures and riches of this world
- Station 11: For those of little faith, who rarely approach the sacraments
- Station 12: For all priests, nuns, and those who dedicated themselves to some form of religious life or community
- Station 13: For those who died without having receiving the sacraments
- Station 14: For all other souls in Purgatory not already mentioned above

Reminder: There is a daily plenary indulgence applicable to the holy souls in purgatory upon completing the Stations of the Cross. It is also advisable to attend daily Mass if possible; receive Eucharist; go to confession: preferably within 8 days prior or after reciting the stations; and upon complete ting the Stations: recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (Our father, Hail Mary and Glory Be).
